It is highly recommended that students do not purchase flights before this date. No additional expenses (flights, visas, etc.) will be refunded if the camp session is cancelled by April 1, 2024.

2. Payment

- All students are required to make a 50% deposit to secure their place and receive their letter of admission.
- The complete payment must be received at least 1 month prior to the start of the camp program. The payment must be received in full.

3. Withdrawal/Refund

- All withdrawals must be submitted in writing.
- Refund requests due to visa denial will be accepted, in writing, until the beginning of each camp session. Refunds due to visa denial are subject to a \$250 CAD non-refundable administrative fee.
- Refund requests for any other reason must be submitted in writing at least one month prior to the first day of the camp session. Refund requests for reasons other than visa denial will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis. The 50% deposit is non-refundable due to withdrawal.
