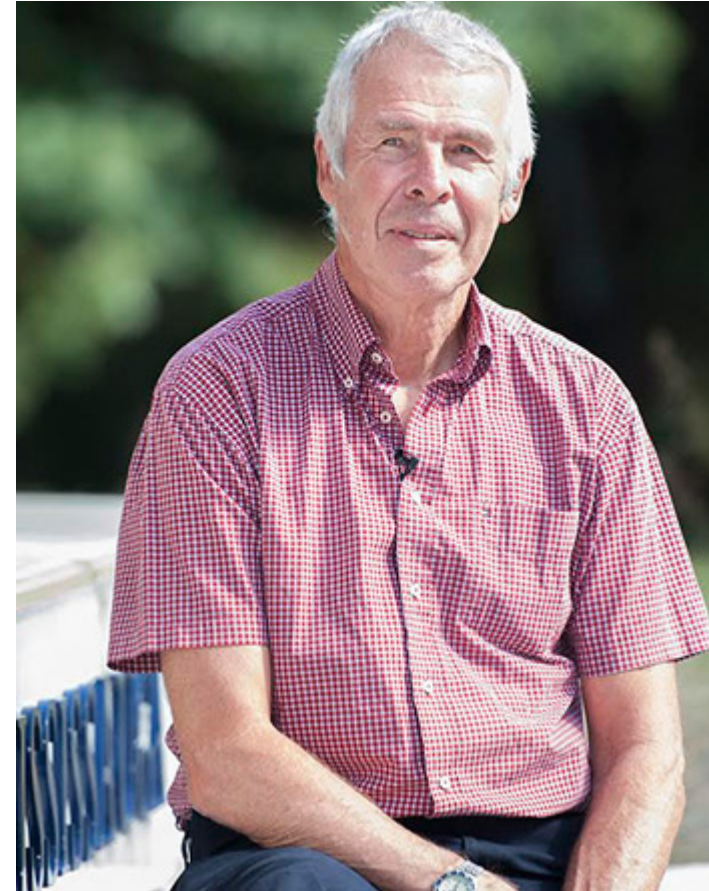

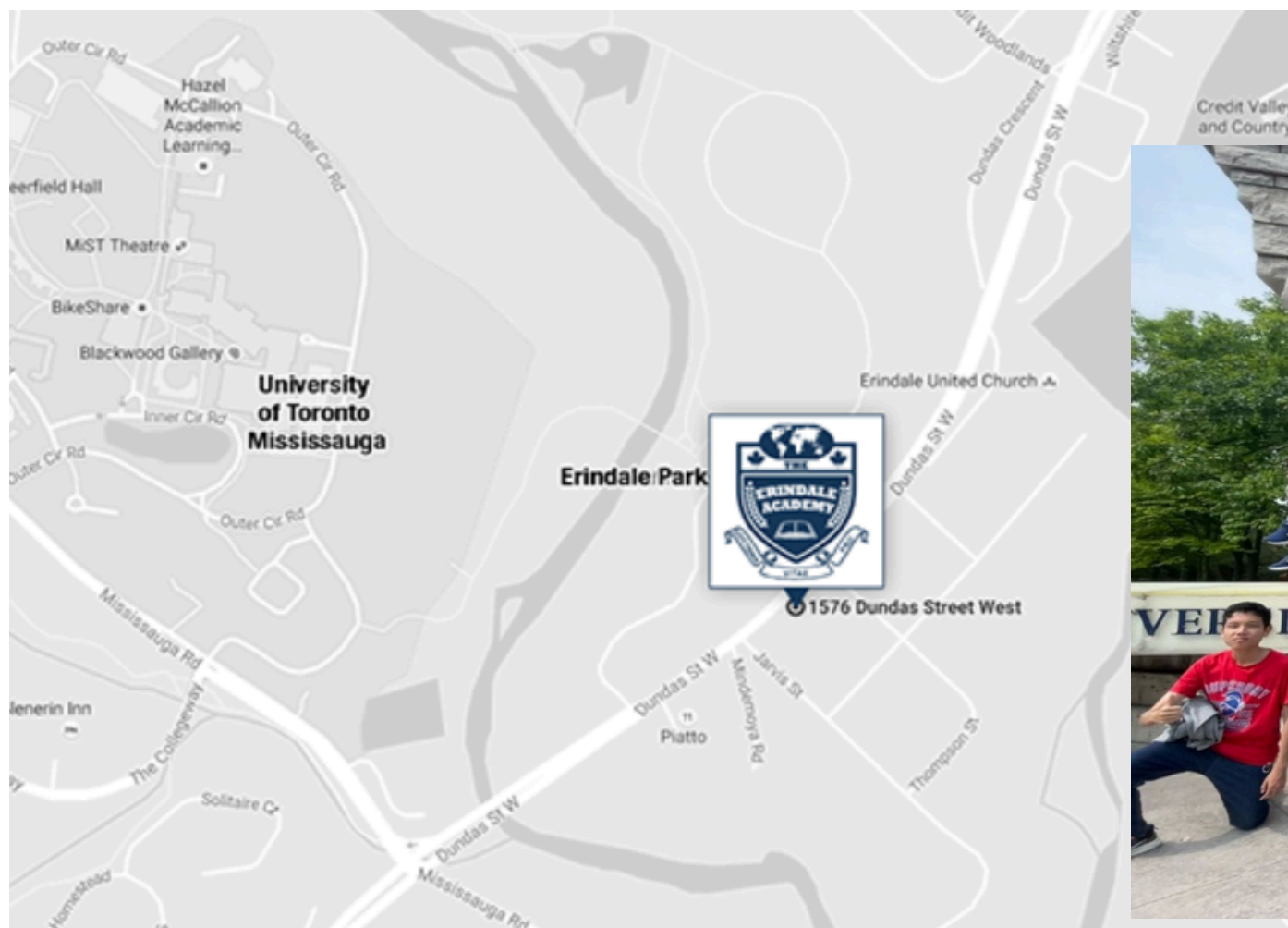

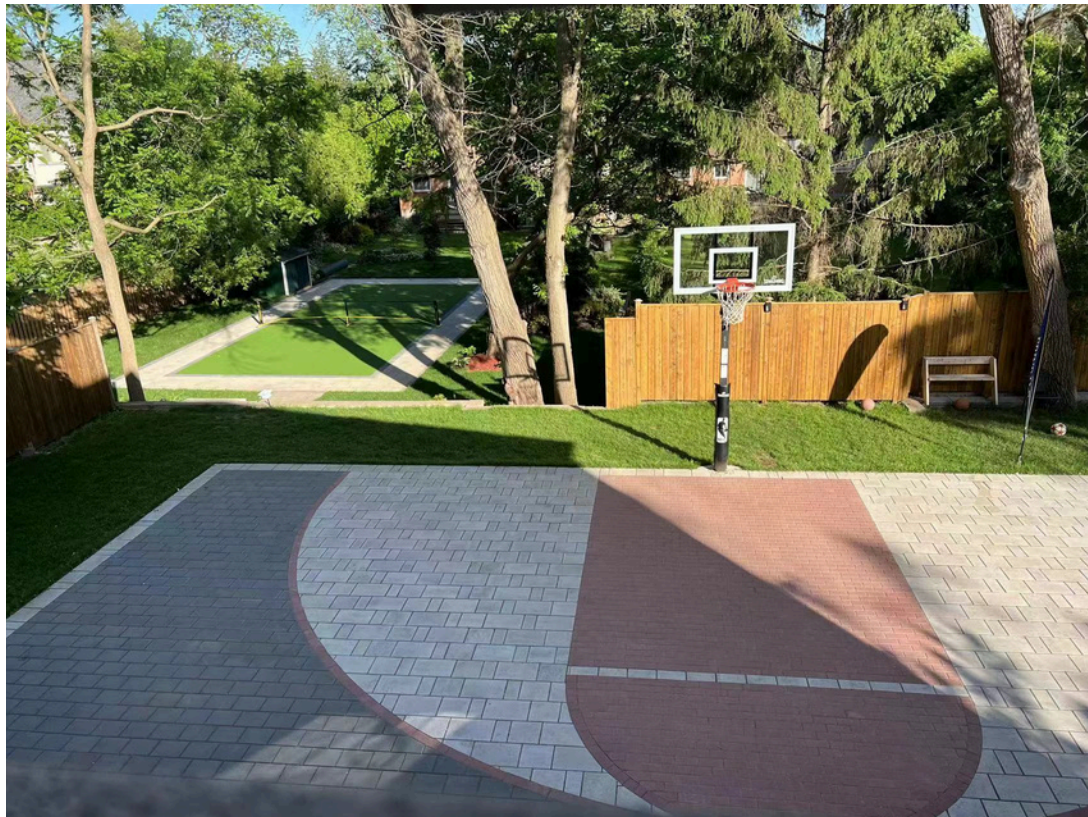

- Private campus equipped with recreational spaces: **pickleball** court, **basketball** court, and **mini-golf** course (other sport facilities are booked outside of the campus)





